1 Evaluation criteria

1.1 General information

The contract will be awarded to the tenderer having submitted the most economically advantageous tender based on the quality criteria.

1.2 Quality criteria

1.2.1 General information

The quality criteria are graded in accordance with the following:

- Technical proposal (100 points)
- Qualification of the experts (100 points)

1.2.2 [Technical proposal] 100 points

- 1. Methodology for conducting factory audits. (30 points)
- 2. Methodology for designing AMR compliant CETPs. (30 points)
- 3. Suggestions for identification of relevant monitoring and solutions approaches. (20 points)
- 4. Suggestions for advancing means of verification and flow of information to strengthen enabling factors like sustainable procurement. (20 points)

1.2.3 [Qualifications of the experts] 100 points

- 1. Experience in pharmaceutical manufacturing and risk management for API and formulations including conducting environmental audits of pharmaceutical factories in India based on the Common Antibiotics Manufacturing Framework and other methodologies. (20 points)
- 2. Experience in designing and or operating common effluent treatment plants in India. (20 points)
- 3. Experience in global and national AMR and environmental policies including zero liquid discharge (ZLD). (15 points)
- 4. Environmental engineering background with good knowledge on environmental management standards. (15 points)
- 5. Experience in developing and implementing monitoring tools and technological solutions to measure and reduce environmental pollution from antibiotic manufacturing. (15 points)
